
June 1, 2016

A specially scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission began at 9:30 a.m. in the Governor's Conference Room at the Arkansas State Capitol. The purpose of this meeting was to present the grant checks to the recipients of the Education and Training and Grant Program. Staff present included Greg Kirkpatrick, Vicki Wright, Gordon McCoy, Crystal Campbell, and Kristi Byers. All Commissioners were present during the meeting with the exception of Duane Neal and Foster Davis, both with excused absences. Also in attendance were Governor Hutchinson, a number of members of the Governor's staff, Julie Chavis with the Attorney General's Office, and all twelve recipients of the grant funds.

The following institutions received grants: Springdale School of Innovation awarded \$10,000.00; Arkansas State University at Newport, Black River Technical College, Cabot High School, Dumas New Tech High School, Pulaski Technical College Saline County Career Center, River Valley Career Academy, Southern Arkansas University Tech, Arkansas High School, University of Arkansas at Fort Smith, and Waldron High School, each awarded \$11,000.00; and Northwest Technical Institute awarded \$29,449.41.

Following the grant presentation in the Governor's Conference Room, the recipients, Commissioners, and Commission staff held a reception honoring these awardees as the inaugural grant class in the Victory Building. Commission Chairman Sandy Stroope and Greg Kirkpatrick made brief remarks to the recipients about the program.
