

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEIDCLE COMMISSION

October 21, 2015

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Sandy Stroope. Staff present included Greg Kirkpatrick, Vicki Wright, Gordon McCoy, and Crystal Campbell. All Commissioners were present during the meeting. Also in attendance were the court reporter Susan Whitson, Julie Chavis with the Attorney General's Office, Hearing Officer Charlie Moulton, Ronald Fair with Golf Cars of Arkansas, and Mindy Wirges with Bowen Law School.

The minutes from the July 15, 2015, meeting were unanimously approved following a proper motion and second.

The Commission unanimously approved the meeting expenditures for the October 21, 2015, meeting following a proper motion and second.

The Commission unanimously approved the fiscal reports for July, August, and September 2015 following a proper motion and second.

The Commission approved the ad hoc committee recommendations as presented.

The Commission then moved to H# 15-016, AMVC vs. Southern Elegance Mfg. LLC dba Golf Cars of Arkansas. Following testimony by Vicki Wright and Ronald Fair, the Commission unanimously approved the Motion to present Golf Cars of Arkansas with a Notice of Warning that they must maintain an active bond to remain a licensed dealer.

The Commission moved to H#15-014, AMVC vs. APT Group Inc. dba Motovox. Following testimony by Vicki Wright and Greg Kirkpatrick, the Commission unanimously revoked Motovox's Distributor license.

Greg Kirkpatrick updated the Commission about a complaint from Tamera Simmons against Roll Out which was resolved following a payment to Tamera Simmons by Roll Out's bond.

Greg Kirkpatrick updated the Commission on the enforcement initiative related to dealers advertising discounts on used vehicles.


The Commission discussed the issue of including a question on salespeople applications related to whether the applicant has ever been convicted of a felony. The commissioners agreed that a conference call should be scheduled with recommendations from staff to finalize the decision on this issue.

The Commission discussed the trend of some dealers utilizing a "Love It or Leave It" exchange policy and how the program is disclosed to consumers. The Commission requested the staff obtain additional information regarding these programs to determine whether additional action needs to be taken.

Greg Kirkpatrick updated the Commission on the progress of the Education and Training Grant Program, and advised the rule is submitted to the Governor's office for approval which is the initial step in the rulemaking process.

Following a very brief discussion on the storage of vehicles, Chairman Stroope accepted a proper motion and second.
